

## Motivational Moments

1. Copy or type up the piece complete with the author's name and your source. Make 26 copies and be sure to 3-hole punch them. Time limit is 3-5 minutes for entire presentation.
2. Read over it a few times so that you can make a good presentation to the class.
3. Decide on at least 3 questions or discussion points for the class regarding your presentation.
4. Be prepared to discuss why this piece is motivational to you and what quality is emphasized. This will be the last point you will share with the class.
5. If you are using a song, you will need to bring the tape or CD (along with my CD player) to class on the day you present.
6. Presentation will be graded on appropriateness of selection, quality of presentation, and application to a UHS student leader's role.

Possible sources - Basic book, "Chicken Soup for the Soul" series, books of quotations or famous speeches, internet, etc.
